Dear Dr. Moise,

We are pleased to inform you that your *application* (Step 1 below) for Registrar has been accepted and approved by the IEEE / ANSI / MC Object ID Oversight Committee. The OID Committee would like to remind you that in order to become a Registrar you must:

1. Submit and have your application approved by the OID committee.
2. *Create* an IEEE 1377 or ANSI C12.19 or MC1219 TDL.
3. Have your TDL certified by an agency selected by the OID committee.

Upon successful certification of your TDL, by an agency selected by the OID committee, you will then be notified of your Registrar status. Upon the receipt of this letter you may indicate to your clients of your current status as a potential Registrar. Only approved Registrars are allowed to distribute the Object IDs and participate in any registry services to the industry. Therefore, until your successful approval to be a Registrar you must refrain from distributing any Object IDs that comes under the jurisdiction of this committee.
